



## Guidelines for Worksite Visit

*Below is essential information as we prepare to visit the Lebanon worksite:*

\*The work day will end around 3:00 with a return time to the school of approximately 3:30-3:45. A cellular phone will be available for communication with parents if an early arrival is expected.

\*It is possible that it will be cold on these days later in the year —Dress accordingly!

\*Lunch is provided.

\*Wear work clothes, but do not wear sneakers unless absolutely necessary. (Work boots are best—this will protect your feet from any nails or other sharp materials that may be on the worksite.)

\*Bring a hammer if possible. There is a lot of nailing that will be taking place on the job, so although tools are provided, it will be helpful to have a few extras! (Please have your name on it or some other way to identify it!)
